Tukad Bangkung Bridge

The **highest bridge** in **Bali Island** and **second highest** in **Southeast Asia**.

This **bridge** height is **71,14 Meters** and the **length of the bridge** is **360 Meters**.

Named after the river that flows below, **Tukad Bangkung River** which also has waterfall at the downstream of the river with the same name.

To access this waterfall we need to hike down **2000 stairs**.

Puncak Mangu

Pucak Tinggan, Pelaga Village

Located at the northernmost village in Badung Regency, Pucak Tinggan.

This place later called as "ujung keris" or "tip of the keris".

Puncak Mangu has elevation level of **2096 Meters** above sea level.

There is a hindu temple on top of Puncak Mangu named **Puncak Mangu Temple.**

Activity: Hiking, Trail running, Worship.



Sari Sekar Gemitir Farm

Gemitir or **Marigold** is a common flower in Bali, Often used by **hindu for prayer**. **Sari Sekar Gemitir Farm** is **marigold farm** and **nursery** located in Tiyingan, Pelaga. They **sell marigold seeds** and **the flower** as well.

Bhumishanti

Bhūmi भूमि Shanti शान्ति

Developed by local farmers and has goal to make **only best quality** coffee beans.


This farm also **process** their coffee by themself from **harvesting to roasting** in order to achieve **best quality coffee.**
